ALFALFA

Class of dormancy: 6,5

Use: hay, dehydrated hay and flour

High speed of regrowth

High number of its stems



## FEATURES

### PHENOTYPE

<b>Class of dormancy</b>	6,5
<b>Plant type</b>	erect
<b>Stem</b>	thin
<b>Plant height</b>	70-75 cm
<b>Leaves</b>	elliptic
<b>Flower</b>	purple/light purple
<b>Relationship leaves/stem</b>	high
<b>Spring vegetative resumption</b>	anticipated
<b>Winter rest</b>	postponed
<b>Cycle</b>	medium-late

<b>Cold</b>	medium resistance
<b>Lodging</b>	excellent resistance
<b>Rust</b>	medium tolerance
<b>Fusarium</b>	medium tolerance
<b>Botrytis</b>	medium tolerance
<b>Cercospora</b>	medium tolerance
